



## Regional Leadership Teams

Recommended Steps to Establish.....

- Identify 5-8 people within Council of Postsecondary Education (CPE) Geographic Responsibility Region: EKV, KSU, Morehead, Murray, NKU, UK, UofL, & WKU
- Consider representatives from the following areas:
  1. Industry
  2. Administration (education)
  3. Non-Profit Organization
  4. Small Business
  5. Media
  6. Government
  7. K-12
  8. Museums
  
- Appoint chair of the regional Leadership Team. This person shall sit on the KGSC LT.
- Regional Leadership Team members serve a two-year term.
- Request team members register with NGCP Program Directory (if applicable)
- As a team, conduct SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, Threats) analysis of region.
- Manage and/or facilitate regional girl-serving activities, e.g. forums
- Design on-line regional communication network, e.g. google groups, facebook
- Recruit diverse girls and girls with disabilities to sponsored events.
- Encourage female mentors to sign up for FABFEBS

What is the role of the Regional Leadership Team?

- Support the statewide KY Girls STEM Collaborative (KGSC) Mission and Values
- Communicate regularly with KGSC
- Help organize and support at least one regional STEM program per year
- Help identify girl serving organizations who are not registered on the website
- Encourage girl organizations from the region to collaborate on mini-grants
- Support and encourage participation in the KGSC statewide Annual Conference

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
